

## Thinking About Future Scenarios

### 1. Introduction: What could happen in the future?

The teacher explains that some changes may happen in the next year. These changes can affect different parts of our lives: our home, school, town, country, or the environment.

The class briefly discusses examples, such as:

- hotter summers
- less plastic at school
- more bikes and fewer cars
- new rules for saving energy
- more trees planted in the town

### 2. Partner Work

Students work in pairs. Each pair chooses **one future scenario** from the activity cards.

Together, they think about:

- What might happen?
- Who would be affected?
- Would the change be mostly positive, negative, or both?
- What could children, families, or schools do?

### 3. Worksheet

Students fill out the worksheet together. They should use short, simple answers and can also draw small pictures.

### 4. Sharing

Each pair presents their scenario to the class. The class compares the answers:

- Which scenario has the most advantages?
- Which scenario would be difficult?
- Which scenario can we influence ourselves?

## 5. Final Discussion

The teacher asks:

**What small action could we take to help make the best future scenario more likely?**

### Activity Cards

#### Card 1: A Very Hot Summer

Next summer is much hotter than usual. There are many sunny days and very little rain.

Think about:

- How would this affect you?
- How would it affect animals and plants?
- What could your school do to stay cool and save water?

#### Card 2: Less Plastic at School

Your school decides to use much less plastic. Students should bring reusable bottles and lunch boxes.

Think about:

- Would this be easy or difficult?
- How would it help the environment?
- What could students do to support this idea?

#### Card 3: More Bikes, Fewer Cars

Your town builds more bike paths. More children and adults start using bikes instead of cars.

Think about:

- How would this change the way people travel?
- Would it be good for the air and the environment?
- What problems could happen?
